- d) Parish has taken over the administration of SSVP families. The monthly SSVP collection is not enough, therefore funds from Project Kasih is also used for this purpose.

 - Mandarin youth group doing ok
 - English youth group not active
 - Fr. Dominic is planning to have an activity on Youth Day

- 4. Synod Questionnaire
 - 99 parishioners responded to the questionnaire (about 6% of the total parish population age 12 years and above)
 - b) 72% responded that we are doing well whereas 28% responded that we are not doing well
 - c) There were several inputs for future improvement, e.g. dialogue with other denominations, to encourage 'passive' parishioners to play a prominent role, organize ecumenical celebrations, leaders to change their attitude, go back to church traditions, Diocese to have centre for those suffering from depression/mental for cheaper consultation, etc.

- b) Election process:
 - pray for God's inspiration and direction
 - surrender to the Lord
 - trust in the Lord
 - i) fix a date for election (to be witnessed by any PAT member)
 - ii) elect chairperson, deputy chairperson, secretary, treasurer, core team
 - iii) outgoing chairperson may act as advisor to the team (optional)
- c) Post election:
 - i) New leader serve with love, humiliation and patience

- a) Meeting with Fr. Dominic on Tuesdays. Parishioners can also meet with any visiting priest (make an appointment
- b) SSVP to recruit young members. BEC leaders to notify their members. To publish in website and bulletin
- c) Responses to Fr. Dominic's question if we are a 'dying' parish:
 - i) probably due to the pandemic
 - ii) restarting slowly
 - iii) pandemic, need to 'encourage' and 'reassure' the people

- iv) cannot wait for leaders to come forward, should approach them. Church of Divine Mercy is vibrant, maybe we don't have the right group to be innovative (put the right people)
- v) give opportunities to a person but don't judge
- vi) people are in a comfort zone, since others are doing the job so they don't come forward
- vii) what is the parish doing to encourage the younger ones to step up
 - → Stephen responded that we should encourage the younger generation to join ministries, give them leadership trainings/formations
- viii) we have to accept the fact that the young ones leave to other states for better opportunities (Butterworth as a township has "stagnated", new townships and industrial estates are being developed at other district, for example Batu Kawan, etc)
- ix) servers need to be re-activated and to have regular meetings
- d) Responses to Fr. Dominic's question on a feedback from the Synod question i.e. are we focussing too much on buildings and less on pastoral?
 - i) we need the new nativity building for so many purposes
 - ii) this assumption could be due to the pandemic and people see churches are focusing on buildings, whereas the people are 'suffering' during the pandemic time. During pandemic churches are closed, probably the church is not aware of the struggles of the people. To get proper statistics of the financial status/those in need.
 - → Fr. Dominic responded that during the pandemic there were no major fund raising projects directed towards building construction.

 Instead, the focus was more on Project Kasih whereby funds were disbursed to those in need. The church/Fr. Dominic will not know who are the needy in the BECs, so leaders should play their part and identify them to the church.
 - iii) Project Kasih in what way is assistance given
 - → Fr. Dominic responded in the form of cash, ration, studies (allowance to students in universities), medical assistance, funeral assistance, etc.
 - iv) there has not been any structural changes in NBVM for so many years and we greatly need the new Nativity centre, i.e. for catechism classes, meetings, etc.
 - → Fr. Dominic informed that there should be a balance. We want to do the best for the people. He also informed that those who are interested to assist to come forward
 - v) when will all the language catechism and functions be held physically?
 - → Fr. Dominic responded that one of the problem is parking space, especially during major activities. This will be resolved once the basement parking is open. (the new building is pending the final stage of obtaining the Certificate of Completion and Compliance)
