
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How does the Eucharist impact my life?

The Eucharist

- most august sacrament in which Christ the Lord himself is contained, offered, and received and by which the Church continually lives and grows
- the summit and source of all worship and Christian life, which signifies and effects the unity of the People of God and brings about the building up of the body of Christ



Eucharist and Ecclesial Communion

- It is a celebration of the whole Church Suffering, Militant and Triumphant Church.
- In every Mass, it is the whole Church that celebrates.
- We cannot celebrate the Eucharist properly when our hearts are closed to forgiveness, reconciliation and communion with the whole Body of Christ.

The Eucharist is never a private affair, personal, individual, a source of grace to withstand the clashes of life, but the Eucharist is the journey of the Community together, going together to the Eucharist to implore His help for you to be in communion with him and among you; to beg him to have mercy of your not being able to be with him and among you, and if able, to make you grow in the capacity to be with him and being with him, to grow in the capacity to live among yourselves.


Duty of the Faithful

Eucharistic Communion


It is not to receive the Bread where He made himself present, BUT, it is to receive Him in the bread while He makes himself present to All and therefore to each one, and He does communion with us.



Eucharistic Adoration

It is going to Christ present in the mystery of the Tabernacle to thank him for the Communion celebrated in the Mass, and continue to echo the experience lived in the **Eucharist of unity.**





When we receive Jesus in the Eucharist, we become what we receive – Jesus the bread of life. If we truly receive Jesus with faith, we should live and manifest his life – a life lived by the grace of the Spirit in obedience to God our Father, and placed at the service of humankind and the world for salvation and reconciliation.

Eucharistic and Self-giving

 As we participate in the Eucharist, we participate in Christ's self-offering.

It is necessary that we make Christ's offering our own by offering with him and in him our sufferings, our difficulties, our trials and still more, our very selves in order to make our gift rise up to the Father together with that which Christ makes of himself.
